How To Apply Peel & Stick Wallpaper

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE APPLYING WALLPAPER TO ENSURE THE BEST POSSIBLE OUTCOME

WHAT YOU NEED:

- 2 PEOPLE
- SQUEEGEE
- STEP LADDER
- STRAIGHT EDGE
- SHARP UTILITY KNIFE

★ Make sure your surface is **clean**, **smooth**, and **dry**. The product may not stick to a **dirty**, **textured**, or **wet** surface. The longer wallpaper is applied, the harder it may be to reposition. ★

HANGING YOUR WALLPAPER:

Applying the first section

Start by hanging your wallpaper in the left corner and peel 4-5 inches of the backer off. It's important to line wallpaper up straight and level for successful installation. Use your squeegee and adhere this section to your wall. Once the starting corner is attached and straight, pull off more of the backing and slowly work your way down the wall using the squeegee to push bubbles out and adhere wallpaper to wall. If you need to reposition, pull up and reapply!

Overlapping

When applying your next section of wallpaper, attach it so that the edge overlaps with the previous strip by 1/8th of an inch while also carefully looking to see that your pattern matches up. Be careful not to push and pull on material too hard as it may cause it to wrap and not line up correctly. **DO NOT TRIM OVERLAP. YOUR PATTERN WILL NOT LINE UP.** Use a straight edge and knife to cut excess

materials.
